PRINCE2 (Projects IN Controlled Environments) is easily adaptable, scalable and tailored, independent from business area, universal project management standard. Originally developed by the United Kingdom government, today it is not only *de-facto* the most popular project management standard in the UK, but it's also widely used all over the World. PRINCE2 is also known for its friendliness to Agile philosophy and its methods. This combined framework is known as **PRINCE2 Agile**.

This course covers the PRINCE2 methodology, principles, themes, processes and terminology, which were updated in 2017. All of these are required for the PRINCE2 Foundation exam, which will be taken on the third day. During the last day of the course, the summary of the PRINCE2 methodology will be covered by the world-famous PRINCE2 trainer, consultant and author Frank Turley.
